

Ubon Ratchathani University Announcement

Intentions to Honestly Administer and Perform Official Duties

In reference to the University's prior announcement of the intentions to honestly administer and perform official duties which has been approved by the University Executive Board in the 2/2017 meeting on February 7th, 2017,

To provide further clarification and be in line with the guidelines of the integrity and transparency assessment in the job performance of governmental agencies in the fiscal year 2018 as issued by Office of the National Anti-Corruption Commission, UBU announces intentions in the administration and execution of official duties as follows:

Ubon Ratchathani University will:

- 1. Carry our jobs or duties according to the University's mission under good governance and good administration. Every step will be taken in strict compliance with the standards, laws, rules, regulations, announcements and cabinet resolutions in order to maintain justice while giving priority to the public benefits and being ready to take responsibility for any possible mistake.
- 2. Uphold honesty, integrity and transparency whereas every form of dishonesty and corruption will not be tolerated.
- 3. Encourage its personnel to be aware of the threats of corruption. A sense of shame and fear of corruption will be instilled in them to the extent that a culture of anti-corruption is sustainably created. This will completely free the university from corruption in terms of policy and duty-related conduct.
- 4. Reinforce the internal audit systems and mechanisms, and cooperate with external auditors so that the prevention and suppression of corrupt activities are effective.
- 5. Realize the guidelines and measures initiated according to the strategies for preventing and suppressing corruption and misconduct in governmental sectors into action which will be specified in the official action plans.
